



GROUNDWORK MINI-GRANT FUND

Overview:

Organizations in any of Groundwork's existing states of focus (Alabama, Mississippi, Oklahoma, and West Virginia) are eligible to apply for funding from the Groundwork Mini-Grant Fund (GMF).

GMF awards range from \$250 to \$2,000 and can be used to cover specific programmatic, education, training or capacity needs related to an organization's central mission and work. GMF applications are accepted and awarded on a rolling basis each month, until Groundwork's monthly GMF budget is exhausted.

While there is no limit to how many times an organization can apply, priority will be given to spreading resources throughout the organizing ecosystem in our states and funding a diverse array of projects and proposals.

The same criteria as Groundwork Organizing Grants will be used for the GMF, which you can [reference here](#).

To Apply:

Organizations wishing to be considered must first [fill out our grant interest form](#) to set up an introductory conversation with our team.

Expeditious decisions will be made on all GMF applications, as we know short-term needs are often time sensitive, but we kindly ask for a lead time of at least two weeks for our team to review the materials and come to a decision.

Please note that applicants for the GMF must have registered legal status (501c3, 501c4 or PAC) or be fiscally sponsored.
